

### 3.2.2 Student Travel Capability Rating Scale

All students who are given a Travel Capability Rating of **A or B will not be eligible** for assistance under this program:

<p><b>A Adult Travel</b> The student can negotiate all public transport services including change of trains, buses and/or ferries.</p>	<p>Students are not eligible for travel assistance.</p>
<p><b>B Independent</b> The student is able to wait at the appropriate place for train, bus and/or ferry and knows where/when to alight. The student is able to board the bus, train and/or ferry and travel safely to the destination.</p>	<p>Students are not eligible for travel assistance.</p>

Students who are given a Travel Capability Rating of **C, D, E or F will be eligible** for assistance under this program:

<p><b>C Semi Independent</b> The student is supervised while waiting at the appropriate place for train, bus and/or ferry. Once aboard train, bus and/or ferry the student can ride unaccompanied but may be met at the destination by an adult or responsible person. The driver/conductor may assist the student to alight at the destination. This category includes students who are conveyed to and/or from school by private motor vehicle rather than being restricted to travelling by public transport.</p>	<p>Students conveyed by bus, train or ferry will be eligible for a refund of their fares.  Students conveyed by private motor vehicle will be eligible for travel assistance at the current kilometric rate per private motor vehicle.</p>	<p>Eligible for assistance</p>
<p><b>D Travel Assisted</b> The student can travel on public transport only when accompanied by a responsible adult. Where transport connections have to be made the presence of an accompanying adult is needed. This category includes students who are conveyed to and/or from school by private motor vehicle rather than being restricted to travelling by public transport.</p>	<p>Students conveyed by bus, train or ferry will be eligible for a refund of their fares. The fares of an escort appointed by the school will be rebated to the school.  Students conveyed by private motor vehicle will be eligible for travel assistance at the current kilometric rate per private motor vehicle.</p>	<p>Eligible for assistance</p>
<p><b>E Dependent</b> The student is not able to use buses, trains or ferries to travel, by reason of his/her disability, but can travel in a vehicle (e.g. private motor vehicle or taxi) that does not require modification.</p>	<p>Students will be eligible for travel assistance at the current kilometric rate per private motor vehicle or taxi.</p>	<p>Eligible for assistance</p>
<p><b>F Most Dependent</b> The student has severe physical disabilities and can only travel in a special purpose vehicle such as a Maxi taxi or mini bus or a private motor vehicle that has been modified to accommodate the student's travel needs.</p>	<p>Students conveyed in a special purpose vehicle will be eligible for travel assistance up to a maximum of \$300 per week, inclusive of any subsidy provided by the Queensland Transport Taxi Subsidy Scheme. Students conveyed in a modified private motor vehicle will be eligible for travel assistance at the current kilometric rate per modified private motor vehicle.</p>	<p>Eligible for assistance</p>
